



Indiana Health Coverage Programs Enrollment Trend Highlights – October 2025



IHCP Program Membership:


Total Membership decreased in October. With **1,731,322** members, there were **19,692**, or **1.12%**, less members in October 2025 than in September 2025. In the last six months, IHCP membership dropped by nearly **240,000**.

Category Membership:

Membership declined across all five major categories again in October. Each category now has fewer members than both its six-month average and its level at the same time last year.

Insights:

The chart shows enrollment changes across HHW categories from March to October 2025. Children ages 6 through 19 remain the largest group with 309,279 members but declined by more than 41,000, the steepest drop. Children ages 1 through 5 form the second-largest group at 154,282, also with a major decrease. Most notable is that while Medicaid categories are losing members, CHIP categories, which cover children with incomes above Medicaid limits, have not gained any.



The values above reflect the percentage difference between the previous month, the six-month rolling average, and the same month last year, respectively.
