IHCP Program Membership:

Total Membership **increased** again in February. With **2,205,100** members, there were **19,140**, or **0.88%**, **more** members in February 2023 than in January 2023.

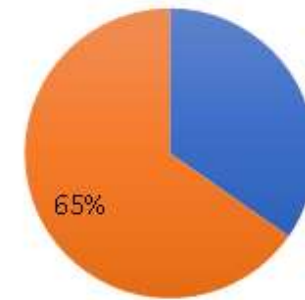
The values above reflect the percentage difference between the previous month, the six-month rolling average, and the same month last year, respectively.

Membership in HIP increased in January by over 1%. HHW membership and FFS membership both grew by less than 1%. Despite being red on all measures, HCC membership remains relatively flat.

The pie graphs on the right show the percentage of Hoosiers that are members of an IHCP. The graph on the top represents children (less than 18 years old), while the graph on the bottom displays the adults. In Indiana, a child is 1.75 times more likely to be on an IHCP than an adult.

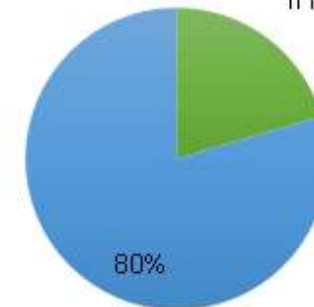
Members of IHCP as a Percentage of Total Population
