



Indiana Health Coverage Programs Enrollment Trend Highlights – September 2025



IHCP Program Membership:


Total Membership decreased in September. With **1,751,014** members, there were **18,562**, or **1.5%**, less members in September 2025 than in August 2025. In the last six months, IHCP membership dropped by nearly **220,000**.

Category Membership:

Membership decreased in all five major categories again in September. Only one number in the September table was positive, the Hoosier Care Connect membership compared to one year ago.

Insights:

The chart shows enrollment changes across HIP categories from September 2024 to September 2025. Regular Plus remains the largest category at 289,307 members but lost over 49,000 enrollees—the steepest decline. State Plan Plus is second-largest at 215,290, also declining significantly. Emergency Services and State Plan Basic switched places, both ending near 49,000 members. Maternity remained stable at 40,451 members, while Regular Basic dropped to just 478 members, approaching its record low of 310.
