



Indiana Health Coverage Programs Enrollment Trend Highlights – May 2026



IHCP Program Membership:

Total Membership decreased in May. With **1,528,969** members, there were **28,575**, or **1.83%**, fewer members in May 2026 than in April 2026. Membership has decreased for thirteen months in a row.

Category Membership:

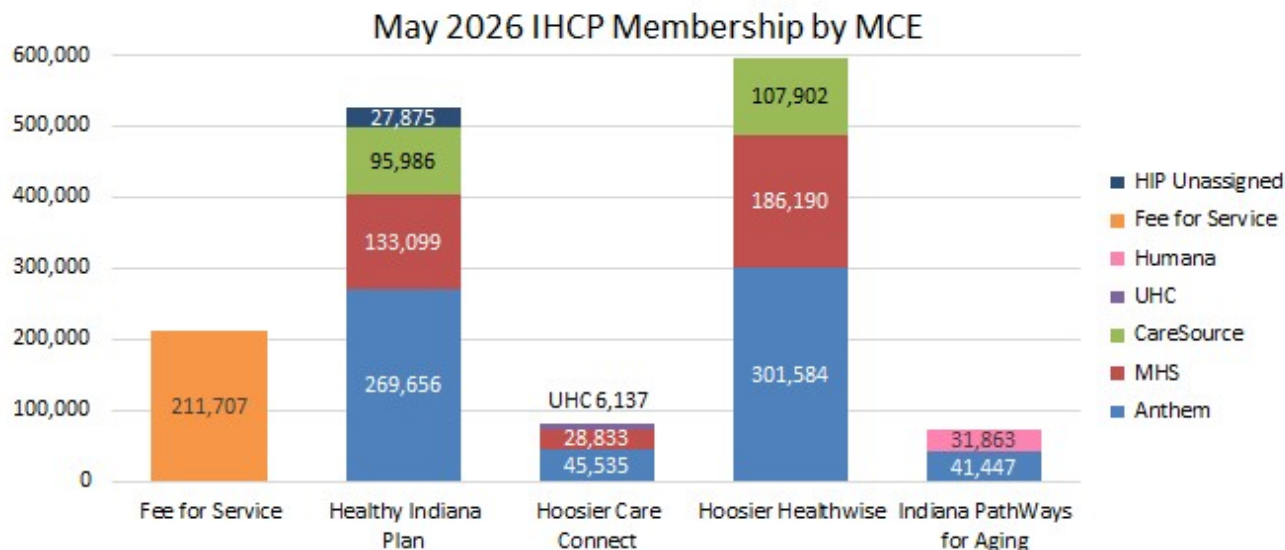
Four of the five major categories decreased in May. HIP lost over 18,000 members. HHW dropped by over 8,000 members, which represents a 34% improvement compared to the 12,000+ members removed in April. HCC was the exception and added 472 members.

Insights:

The chart below shows how many members are in each Managed Care Entity (MCE) and Fee for Service (FFS). Indiana pays directly for every individual visit or procedure with FFS. Under the Managed Care Model, the state pays a private insurance company a set monthly fee per member to manage and deliver care through a specific network. Indiana currently contracts with five MCEs, but they do not all participate in each program. HIP Unassigned members are in a special category where payments are covered as FFS.
