



Indiana Health Coverage Programs Enrollment Trend Highlights – August 2024



IHCP Program

Membership:

Total Membership decreased in July. With **1,965,254** members, there were **197**, or **-0.01%**, fewer members in August 2024 than in July 2024.

Category Membership:

For the first time since April 2023, Hoosier Healthwise (HHW) gained members. Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP), Fee For Service (FFS) and PathWays for Aging (PWA) all lost members, while Hoosier Care Connect (HCC) added a little over 200 members.

Insights:

The chart to the right displays the number of individuals on Refugee Medical Assistance. This subcategory of Fee for Services is a temporary program Refugees receive upon arrival. This category has seen exponential growth since the Public Health Emergency (PHE) and is showing no signs of decreasing. At well over 8,000 members, the current level is ten times the record set before the PHE.
