### PASSENGERS ARE NOW ALLOWED TO TRANSFER IN TAOYUAN AIRPORT (TPE)



Travelers can now use TPE to connect for beyond destinations in Asia, in addition to the existing connection airports of ICN, TYO, HKG for Asia region. Since 25th June, 2020 the Central Epidemic Command Center of Taiwan has lifted bans on international air passengers traveling through Taiwan Taoyuan Airport with the following conditions:

- Passenger transferring / transiting through TPE is not permitted to enter the country.
- Transfer to and from Mainland China is not permitted (excluding Hong Kong and Macau).
- Transit passengers are required to fly with the same airline group.
- Connecting time between flights must be less than 8 hours on the same day.
- Please double check the entry requirements of your final destination before making your reservation.

Upon arrival, transfer/ transit passengers will be segregated from non-transit passengers and be guided through security checkpoints to designated gates by airline ground staff.



## AIR CANADA DISCONTINUES SERVICES ON 30 REGIONAL ROUTES

AC will be suspending services on 30 domestic routes and closing eight station at regional airport indefinitely due to the decrease in demand for air travel caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
