Event Overview: The Alaska Water and Wastewater Agency Response Network (AKWARN) in coordination with the Alaska Water and Wastewater Management Association (AWWMA) is hosting a free U.S. EPA-sponsored tabletop exercise (TTX) event. The TTX will provide an opportunity for participants to discuss emergency response to a hypothetical incident affecting water and wastewater systems.
