## WHAT IS A DISPARITY STUDY?

The Commonwealth has hired **BBC Research & Consulting** to conduct a *disparity study* to assess whether any barriers exist for minority- and woman-owned businesses that make it more difficult for them to compete for Commonwealth contracts. The disparity study will:

- Measure participation of minority- and woman-owned businesses in Commonwealth contracting
- Measure availability of minority- and woman-owned businesses for Commonwealth contracting
- Assess marketplace conditions for minority- and woman-owned businesses
