We Crave is a comprehensive educational and inspirational series on the topic of opioid (and other) addictions. The series presents information in a reflective setting that includes videos, images and music to provide both an educational and transformational experience.

The series is free and open to all, including those who are suffering from addiction, their loved ones, any anyone who would like to learn more. We Crave will be offered monthly through September, beginning in June. Each course includes four two-hour sessions (biology, psychology, sociology and spirituality). **You can attend the entire series or individual sessions.**

CEs are available for professionals, the National Association of Social Workers (PA-NASW), and Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC). In order to receive CEs, you must participate in a total of four sessions, representing each of the topics. Fees apply for CEs.
