Dr. Crawford explained to us that although it is rare with Alimta (chemo drug), it may cause Inflammation in his lungs. I told Dr. Crawford, if it's rare, Alan is all over it. His chemo was discontinued today for now. He will have a Broncoscopy for a lung biopsy within a week or two. If the biopsy shows pneumonitis, he will be treated with steroids. Dr. Crawford will then decide if he will change the type of chemo. Alan's breathing has worsened to wear he wears the oxygen when he exerts himself, which lately that does not take much.
