SETCDC Construction Manager Position Description (Hurricane Harvey Recovery)

Reports To: SETCDC President

Job Description:

The SETCDC Construction Manager is a full-time salary position that is expected to oversee all aspects of construction projects, including assessments, for SETCDC (in cooperation with UCC Disaster Ministries) as it pertains to the rehabilitation of properties damaged by Hurricane Harvey and/or properties that will be used to house persons/families displaced by Hurricane Harvey.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Works with the UCC Volunteer Coordinator, UCC Disaster Ministries Hurricane Harvey Coordinator and volunteers to assist in recovery from Hurricane Harvey.
- 2. Oversees the repair or rebuild of client homes to a safe, sanitary, secure and functional condition.
- 3. Coordinates the supply of materials, equipment, tools, volunteers, contractors, and inspectors required for the completion of the home repair projects.
- 4. Conducts project inspections and provides written estimates for labor and materials.
- 5. Secures all components needed to complete home repair projects including timely acquisition of materials, equipment and tools.
- 6. Guides, directs and supervises the work of the SETCDC Construction Site Supervisor
- 7. Supervises and coordinates the work of all volunteers and contractors in order to ensure safety, quality workmanship and high morale.
- 8. Orients volunteers to project expectations and assigns specific jobs according to their skills and abilities.
- 9. Maintains accurate records of construction progress and financial accounts for each project.
- 10. Completes all essential documentation and reports.
- 11. Manages and controls building funds, tools, and equipment
- 12. Manages tool and equipment inventories, maintenance, repairs, and replacement
- 13. Demonstrates and teaches safe and appropriate construction skills and techniques to volunteers.
- 14. Completes necessary assessments and itemized project estimates.
- 15. Meets with appropriate building inspectors and has working knowledge of standard codes and constructions

- 16. Cultivates effective relationships with partner agencies, inspectors, vendors, and the community.
- 17. Coordinates with SETCDC President in prioritizing projects.

Basic knowledge in plumbing, electrical and HVAC

Working knowledge of local and International Building Code

Modest computer skills such as spreadsheets (Excel), documentation (Word), Email, Google searches

Desirable computer skill with estimation packages (Xactimate)

Experience managing construction projects

Experience supervising construction workers

Problem solving experience

Experience estimating entire construction projects

Ability to work with people of all ages, ethnic and religious backgrounds

Ability to work with team members

Ability to be flexible in changeable situations

A positive and engaging attitude/disposition

A burning desire to see all projects through to completion
