**Location and Accommodations**

Camp Calumet, in Freedom, NH, is located on beautiful Lake Ossipee, and is one of the region's oldest and most attractive conference and camping facilities. (Its sponsor, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America [New England Synod], is an ecumenical partner with the UCC through the 1997 Lutheran-Reformed *Formula of Agreement*.) We will be meeting in the main building, which includes a spacious dining room and has internet access. Recreational facilities (swimming, canoeing and kayaking, hiking) are available, and excellent shopping opportunities are a short drive away for those who wish to bring family along for vacation, or spend a leisurely weekend between sessions. Cost for ten days' meals and housing in the Conference Center, excluding weekends, is roughly \$700 per person. Weekend fees vary, for those who wish to remain on the campus. **Register for the Institute as a non-credit certificate student.** You will be required to participate in every class and to complete assignments, papers, and exams. Final work is due August 1. Students successfully completing all work will receive a certificate of completion, verifying to Church and Ministry Committees that they have fulfilled all requirements for UCC Polity. **Registration cost: \$525.**

Some students presently enrolled in seminary may desire academic credit for this course. Please contact the dean or registrar of your school if you want credit. This course was formerly offered by Andover Newton Theological School, and it meets all relevant seminary requirements. However, arrangement for credit must be made individually by seminarians and their schools.
