St. Luke's University Health Network CPE Center is excited to announce its 2024 Spring-Fall Extended Internship Unit!

The unit will focus on *Spiritual Care with People affected by Mental Illness and Addiction*, will take place May 6-November 22, 2024.

Unit Duration: 29 weeks

Weekly Commitment: 15 hours per week

Educational work: 5 hours of supervised education and 10 hours of spiritual care practice in the clinic



Clinical Contexts: Daytime educational and clinical work will take place at St. Luke's Penn Foundation (Sellersville), and overnight/weekend on-calls at St. Luke's Bethlehem campus (Bethlehem).

Cost of Training: No Application Fee.

If you are accepted, the tuition for the unit is \$450, with \$150 non-refundable deposit upon acceptance into the program to hold your spot, and \$300 remainder of the fee due at the beginning of the unit.

This part-time unit is designed especially for those who are in ministry or ministry training and wish to have an experience of chaplaincy in a community-based clinical setting. It will also be a good fit for other caregiving professionals who seek to deepen the spiritual dimension of their work.
