JOB DESCRIPTION

- Coordinate music with the Worship Committee for weekly services and special services.
- Accompany Choir on piano.
- Fill in for Organist's vacations.
- Growth in the Sunday School program would initiate the need for a Junior Choir. This would entail a pay increase.
- Choir Director is a member of "Worship Committee" which meets monthly.
- Responsible to schedule Piano maintenance and regular tuning.
- Responsible for monitoring and filling the piano humidifier with distilled water as needed.
