JU Dress Rehearsal

What time should I arrive?

Please refer to your report time on the dress rehearsal schedule. We know our dancers are super excited for this special day however, please arrive no earlier than your scheduled time. Dancers will check in at the auditorium lobby entrance. Each class will be allotted a block of time so please do your best to arrive on time.

Does my dancer come dressed & ready?

Yes, all dancers should arrive dressed and ready in full costume, hair, and make up. We can't wait to see everyone's beautiful costumes!!

What if my dancer has more than one class?

Dancers will not be able to wait in the lobby or auditorium in between dances that are rehearsing. If your dancer has quick changes a dressing room assignment will be emailed to you prior to dress rehearsal.

How long will I be at dress rehearsal?

Dancers should expect to be at dress rehearsal for approximately one hour after their report time.

How many people can attend?

One chaperone per dancer will be allowed to attend dress rehearsal this year.

Will masks be required?

Yes, masks must be worn at all times. Dancer masks will be provided by the studio at dress rehearsal. Please wear your own mask to dress rehearsal and dancers will change into their class masks before going on stage.





How will the classes be distanced?

During your dancer's scheduled block there will be 2-3 other classes scheduled as well. Classes will be spread out in the auditorium in separate sections to allow for safe social distancing.

Will there be sanitation breaks?

Yes, our JU Staff and Eastern High School janitorial service staff will be on site all day to keep the auditorium and backstage a safe place for all dancers and chaperones.

Can we take pictures/video while our dancers are on stage?

Yes!! Document every moment! You can take as many pictures and videos as you would like. Don't forget to tag us on Facebook and Instagram!

How does my dancer get their professional pictures taken?

Studio K will be set up to take pictures at dress rehearsal. After your dancer's class performs on stage, chaperones will meet them in the gymnasium behind the stage for pictures. Pictures will be taken one class at a time to allow for safe social distancing.

Will this year's recital apparel be on sale?

Yes!! JU is excited to offer all dancers this year's NEW recital apparel at dress rehearsal. Families will be able to purchase apparel during their scheduled block. Don't wait to make your purchase, as sizes may sell out! Don't forget to wear your recital apparel during our JU Spirit Week!

Recital Tickets

When will tickets go on sale?

All tickets will go on sale Saturday, May 15th at 2:00 pm. All families will receive an access code to purchase tickets for their scheduled shows. It is very important that your Studio Director parent portal email is up to date. Please contact the front desk with any changes. After the initial ticket sale we will open up the sale again on Saturday, May 22nd for any tickets that have not been sold. These tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis. No tickets will be sold at the door!



How many tickets can I buy?

Each recreational dancer will be able to purchase up to **6 tickets** for their scheduled show.

Will the seats be socially distanced?

Yes. The ticket system automatically assigns holds on either side of purchased seats to allow for distancing between parties.

How do I purchase tickets?

Tickets will be sold at tututix.com. The link & QR code can be found on our website (www.ibjazz.com) & Social media accounts @ Jazz Unlimited Dance Studio or @judancestudio.

If I have issues purchasing tickets who do I contact?

Is there a chance my dancer's show will sell out?

There is a chance that your dancer's show will sell out. Please plan to purchase tickets on May 15th.

Will there be a livestream?

There will not be a livestream option available. However, JU will be hosting a virtual watch party on Sunday, June 13th . All recital videos will be posted for free on our website! Join us on social media as we celebrate our recital performances!

If my dancer is in multiple shows in a day, can we stay in the auditorium?

We kindly ask that dancers and families exit the building in between shows to allow for sanitization and cleaning of the performance venue.



Recitals

What time should we arrive?

Dancers should arrive ready to dance!! Please have them dressed in costume, full hair and make up. Dancers should arrive approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of the show. Dancers will enter through the auditorium lobby entrance doors. One chaperone may escort them to the gymnasium behind the stage.

Where will the dancers wait before & after their performance?

Dancers will stay backstage in the gymnasium with their teacher while they wait for the show to conclude. Dancers will be spread out in the gym in separate sections to allow for safe social distancing.

Will my dancer be able to watch the show from the audience?

Dancers will not be able to join the audience, however JU is working with Eastern High School's tech team in order to have the performances streamed so the kids can cheer on their fellow JU dancers from the gymnasium!



My dancer takes two classes and both routines are in the same show.

Can I go backstage to help my dancer?

If they have multiple routines in one show there will be JU Staff members in the dressing room to assist with costume changes. If your dancer has multiple costume changes, please have their costumes and shoes labeled and readily available in a small bag or garment bag.

Will my dancer participate in the finale at the end of the show?

Yes!! All JU dancers will be required to participate in this fun tradition at the end of the show. After the finale the dancers will return to the gymnasium. We ask that only one chaperone report to pick up their dancer.

How long will the show be?

Each show will be approximately 1 hour. We kindly ask that all dancers and family members exit the building after the close of the show to allow for sanitizing and cleaning prior to the following show. We welcome our families to take pictures outside to celebrate their dancers!

Will masks be required?

Yes, all members of the audience will need to wear masks during the show. Dancer masks will be provided by the studio at recital. Please wear your own mask to recital and dancers will change into their class masks before going on stage.

Will there be a concession stand?

This year JU will not be able to sell refreshments. Our shows will be shorter this year and there will be no intermission during the shows.
