In this instance, girls in the troop will still earn the following patches as long as their items sold have been entered at the appropriate qualifying levels: Explore, Be Brilliant, Super Seller, Mag Super Seller, Smiles 4 Military, Goal Achiever, Online, Get Social, My Patch Creation, Super Sweet Success Club, 100th Anniversary and 2016 Patch. All other items will not be received in lieu of the additional proceeds.

The selection to opt-out of rewards MUST be made by the TTKC under the "Troop" section of Nut-E before submitting their troop order October 23. ALL girls in the troop must agree to this request by signing in the lines below. This form should be submitted to GSGATL (5601 North Allen Road, Mableton, GA 30126) with your final paperwork for verification of proceeds due to your troop. A copy of the completed agreement should be shared with the parents of each Girl Scout in your troop.

Note: When this selection is made in Nut-E, any additional proceeds the troop is due will be automatically generated by the system, which will reflect the amount of troop proceeds to be withheld by the troop and the proper balance due to GSGATL at the close of the program.
