Greetings from the Ohio Division of Orphan Grain Train!

We praise and thank God, for the blessings He provides to us daily and of those blessings, you and your church members are what we are extremely thankful for!

Our Ohio Division remains busy as we continue to serve those in need by providing humanitarian aid. Since December of 2021, we delivered four 16-foot trailers of furniture, household items, clothing, blankets & toys to Kentucky, in the areas devastated by tornados. This week we helped to finish loading a semi-trailer with more items heading to Kentucky *{that load nearly depleted our warehouse a few weeks ago, it made its way to several other stops to continue to fill the trailer and then returned to OGT and we finished it off....filled in all the "air" space and now it is on to Kentucky}*. We have sent monetary donations to help with the rebuild in Kentucky of over \$16,000.00. Two trailers of blankets and clothing were delivered to our Indiana OGT Branch and added to their shipment to assist Ukraine refugees along with over \$5,000.00 monetary donations to assist with air cargo shipments from our headquarters in Norfolk NE to assist the people of Ukraine. Monetary donations were sent to assist with the purchase of hay, fencing and fuel to assist cattle ranchers in Texas.

None of this would be possible without the prayers and support from many individuals and congregations throughout the Ohio District.

The enclosed brochure is an invitation to an Open House at our warehouse in Napoleon, OH. We would like people to see our operation, learn more about what we collect (and don't collect) and meet some of our volunteers as well as provide an opportunity for us to personally thank everyone for their continued support of Ohio Division of Orphan Grain Train.
