Registration opens October 28, 2024, for Thanksgiving Turkey Distribution

Qualifying households of three or more, with at least one child under the age of sixteen in their household, are encouraged to register to receive a Thanksgiving dinner.

Registration opens November 11, 2024, for Christmas Castle

Qualifying families with children aged sixteen and under are invited to register for a scheduled time to receive a food gift card and gifts for each child in the household.

Your registration will be confirmed once you complete the verification process.

Items needed for verification:

- Birth Certificate of each child in your household.
- Financial need (MassHealth Card, WIC, SSI, current pay stub, etc.)
- Photo ID for each adult living in the household.
- Proof of residence (current home, gas, cable, utility bill, etc.)

*ALL clients **must** provide child's birth certificate, proof of residency, photo ID, proof of financial need.

Christmas in the City 2024 – Thanksgiving and Christmas Assistance

They will be hosting several small-in-scale parties for those living in shelters they are currently partnering with. There is no application process for these events, which are run through the shelters. Please check with your shelter manager to see whether they are working with Christmas in the City this year. Those in shelters that are not currently partnering with them are welcome to register for Jake's Toy Mania.

Jake's Toy Mania - Provides gifts for Boston-area families in need, but not experiencing homelessness with children sixteen and under.

You must register in advance, and in person.

Sign-up Location: 34 BROMFIELD STREET in Boston (Downtown Crossing). Sign-ups will be held on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday from 11AM-6PM on these dates: November 8th, 9th, 10th, November 15th, 16th, 17th, November 22nd, 23rd, 24th, November 29th, 30th, December 1st, December 6th, 7th, 8th.

December 8th is the final date on which you can sign up for Jakes's Toy Mania.

USPS - Writing to Santa Program

USPS offers the Operation Santa Program to pair letters from kids and families with generous people who fulfill their holiday wishes.

This program provides a connection to gift and clothing donations.

Children can write their wish list to send to Santa starting September 16th. Letters to USPS Operation Santa must be postmarked no later than December 9th. Anyone can write a letter, but please note that the program relies on the generosity of others and cannot guarantee a gift. My Brother's Keeper - Christmas Assistance

General Information:

- All services are free.
- Assistance is provided by delivery only — no pick-ups at our facility.
- Our Christmas Assistance Program serves families all over eastern Massachusetts including Boston and Cape Cod. We do not go to Framingham or points west.
- All requests are processed by phone. We cannot accept e-mail requests or requests made in-person at our facility due to staffing limitations.
- Our Christmas Assistance Line is busy because we serve families from so many communities.
- We will ask for the names, birthdates, clothing size, and gift ideas for each person in your family living at your home.
- My Brother's Keeper only accepts requests from parents in need. We do not accept second-hand requests from family, friends, or advocates. (For example, "I'm calling for a friend who needs help.")

- Gift ideas are suggestions only- we do not guarantee to provide specific gifts.
- My Brother's Keeper cannot give out high-end electronic items like iPods, cell phones, or game systems.
- Gifts are delivered directly to homes sometime between December 1st – 24th. Our volunteers call ahead to schedule delivery appointments. To help with scheduling, our intake staff will always ask for two telephone numbers when processing requests.

How to request gifts for your family:

If your family could use assistance this holiday season, follow the instructions below so Globe Santa can help: <https://globesanta.org/aboutreq.aspx>

Globe Santa does not accept family letters without a holiday gift verification form. Families who have children 12 years old or younger and live in Globe Santa's delivery area can submit a holiday gift verification form from the **Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA)** or another approved agency.

Follow these steps to request holiday gifts for children:

1. Tell us your story. Write a letter to Globe Santa describing your situation or telling us why you are seeking holiday gifts for your children. Do not include a wish list or gift ideas.
2. Finish your forms. **Complete and sign your Holiday Gift Verification Form from the Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA)** or another approved agency.
3. Check the envelop contents. Before you send your request, confirm your family letter and verification form are included in the envelope. Letters received without a verification form cannot be processed!
4. **Mail your request.** Send your letter and completed verification form to the following address **by November 1st:**

About DTA Holiday Gift Verification Forms

- DTA families who live in our coverage area and have children 12 years old or younger can submit to Globe Santa a Holiday Gift Verification Form. If you have not received your verification form, contact the DTA at (877) 382-2363.
- Your Holiday Gift Verification Form must include your current address and a complete list of the eligible children in your household.

If the Holiday Gift Verification Form is not correct, you must notify DTA in one of the following ways:

1. Best way: Update your information using DTA Connect. Print the screen from DTA Connect that shows your updated address or additional children. Mail this

printed page along with your completed Holiday Gift Verification Form that includes your letter on the back.

2. Another way: Visit your local DTA office to update your information and request a new Holiday Gift Verification Form. Mail this updated Holiday Gift Verification Form that includes your letter on back.

Carter American Legion Post No. 16, Drive Boston, Community Center, etc.) in your immediate area and register with them to request toys that have been issued from their program.

Other Resources for Free Toys for Kids this Holiday Season:

- Local churches can be valuable resources to tap into. Many help families in need during the holidays.
- Local Buy Nothing Facebook groups and Freecycle are suitable places to find free second-hand toys.
- You can connect with your child's PCP and learn if their hospital or clinic has a holiday toy event for their patients.
- If your child/youth is receiving Behavioral in-home therapy, Behavioral outpatient therapy or if an Intensive Care Coordinator or Family Partner is working with you and your family, they are also a major source of support for holiday assistance.
