**ORDER**



On September 29, 2025, the parties appeared, by counsel, on the Rule to Show Cause issued against the Respondent, AJP Educational Foundation d/b/a American Muslims for Palestine (the “Respondent”) ordering it to appear before this Court and show cause why it should not be held in contempt for violating the Court’s Order entered on June 13, 2025, requiring the Respondent to respond and fully comply with a Civil Investigative Demand initiated by the Petitioner on October 27, 2023.

Upon due consideration of the Petitioner’s Motion for Rule to Show Cause (the “Motion”), the Rule to Show Cause, the arguments of the parties, and for the reasons stated from the bench, the Court hereby **FINDS** that Respondent is in civil contempt of the Court’s Order of June 13, 2025. In accordance with this finding,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:**

1. Respondent shall fully comply with the Court's Order of June 13, 2025, by Oct 3, 2025. Failure to do so shall subject Respondent to sanctions of \$1,000 per day, to commence on that date, until Respondent fully complies;
2. Respondent shall pay the Petitioner's reasonable costs and attorneys' fees associated with bringing its Motion, in the amount of \$800;
3. The parties shall appear before this Court at Oct 28 on 12:00 p.m., 2025 to assess whether the Respondent has fully complied with the Court's Order and to determine whether any sanctions are due to the Commonwealth;
4. Respondent shall bring Osama Abu Irshaid, its Director, or another officer or director with knowledge of the Attorney General's Civil Investigative Demand ("CID") and the Respondent's efforts to respond to the CID, to the hearing set forth in Paragraph 3, *supra*; and
5. The Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to the parties.
