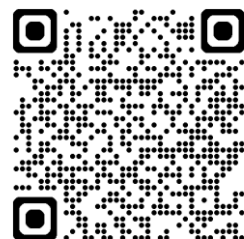

Day 1: Sunday, April 4, 2027 Overnight Flight An overnight flight transports you to stunning landscapes, lively cities, and stirring history.

Day 2: Monday, April 5, 2027 Edinburgh, Scotland Arrive in Edinburgh, the historic capital of Scotland, where rocky hills tower in the distance and the shadows of history can be seen around every corner. With no planned activities today, settle in to discover Scotland's capital and see how medieval crossroads blend seamlessly with a vibrant modern energy. This evening, delve into Scottish culture with a whisky experience and dinner highlighting the flavors of Scotland, and meet your fellow travelers. (D)

Day 3: Tuesday, April 6, 2027 Edinburgh Today get acquainted with Scotland's regal capital on a locally guided city tour exploring both the Old and New Towns. Explore the Royal Mile on foot and walk up the hill to Edinburgh Castle, home of the Scottish Crown Jewels. This afternoon is yours to further explore independently. Tonight, consider an optional excursion including dinner to Rosslyn Chapel, one of Edinburgh's most remarkable medieval buildings – an after-hours private tour will take you deep into this well-known setting from *The Da Vinci Code*. 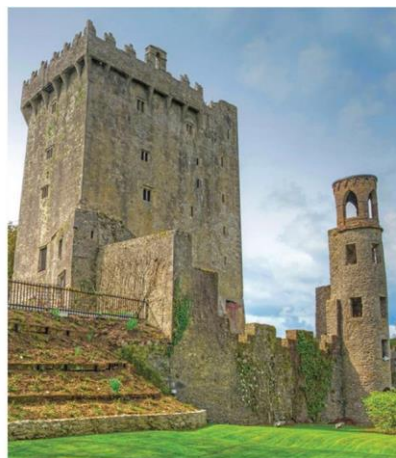
Day 4: Wednesday, April 7, 2027 Edinburgh - Scottish Borders - England - York Depart Edinburgh, traveling through the picturesque countryside of Northumberland by motor coach. Visit a family farm situated in the heart of the Scottish Borders, where sustainability and innovation are core to their business. Later on this evening, arrive in York, with its medieval city walls and snickelways. (B, L)

Day 5: Thursday, April 8, 2027 York Take in York's rich and storied history while joining your Tour Manager on a leisurely orientation walking tour. Explore the quaint, narrow streets of the Shambles that appear today almost as they did during the Middle Ages. At the heart of the city is its impressive Minster, the largest Gothic cathedral in northern Europe. Venture inside and stand in awe of the seemingly endless sea of stained-glass windows. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon and evening at leisure. (B)

Day 6: Friday, April 9, 2027 York - London Board a high-speed train to London. Upon arriving in England's bustling capital, enjoy a traditional afternoon tea. Afterward, join a local expert for a walking tour of the city. At Westminster, see the exteriors of the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, and Big Ben, and continue on to see the exterior of Buckingham Palace, the London home to Britain's royalty since 1837. After checking into your hotel, the evening is yours to explore the vibrancy of London's nightlife. (B, L)

Day 7: Saturday, April 10, 2027 London Step into the formal world of the British Monarchy when you visit the stately and expansive Windsor Castle. His Majesty King Charles III uses Windsor as both a private home and as a royal residence where formal duties of state are performed. Windsor's 1000 rooms comprise the largest inhabited castle in the world. It dates back to the 1070's, when William the Conqueror built the original wooden structure, now replaced by the grand stone edifices. Explore one of Britain's most visited historic buildings, its precincts, and the State Apartments, which house a delightful collection of royal art treasures. Enjoy time for lunch in the quaint town of Windsor before heading back to London. This once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to visit the castle that houses so much British history and lore is not to be missed! (B)

Day 8: Sunday, April 11, 2027 London - Bath - Cardiff, Wales Travel to Bath, the elegant Georgian town, to visit the Roman Bath Museum's 2000-year-old elaborate spas. Stroll through Bath's cobblestone streets and soak in its old-world atmosphere. Your day ends in the Welsh capital of Cardiff. (B)

Day 9: Monday, April 12, 2027 Cardiff Join a local expert on a leisurely-paced walking tour of Cardiff. Later, travel to historic Blarney Castle. Make your way to the top of the castle, lie back and kiss the famous Blarney Stone. Legend has it that if you do, you will be blessed with the "gift of eloquence." This evening, it's ***Diner's Choice...***

choose your included dinner from a “menu” of Killarney's great restaurants. (B, D)

Day 12: Thursday, April 15, 2027 Killarney - Ring of Kerry - Killarney This morning, explore Killarney National Park on a traditional jaunting car ride.* Then, travel along the glorious Ring of Kerry where you'll find some of Ireland's most magical scenery, and enjoy a brief stop at the historic Kerry Bog Village Museum and the Atlantic Irish Seaweed farm. Marvel at the vistas created by windswept cliffs, rugged mountains, lakes and picturesque villages. Enjoy an evening in Killarney at your leisure. (B)

Day 13: Friday, April 16, 2027 Killarney - Rock of Cashel - Dublin
Venture through the “Golden Vale” en route to the awe-inspiring Rock of Cashel. Take in its imposing facade and visit the spot where St. Patrick preached. Next, continue on to vibrant Dublin, Ireland’s cosmopolitan capital, and visit the magnificent Christchurch Cathedral for a guided tour and drinks reception. (B)

Day 14: Saturday, April 17, 2027 Dublin Today, **it's your choice!** Choose to ride with a local guide to see St. Patrick's Cathedral, O'Connell Street, the General Post Office, and the historic Phoenix Park **-OR-** choose a walking tour of the city's historic center, exploring St. Stephen's Green, Grafton Street, and the River Liffey. Day 15: Sunday, April 18, 2027 Dublin - Tour Ends Depart today with many fond memories of lovely Britain and Ireland. (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until Oct 05, 2026, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

During this tour, you will cross the Irish Sea by ferry. Travelers prone to seasickness and/or motion sickness should take proper precautions. This crossing is approximately 4 hours.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

There are a number of sites where walking on uneven surfaces such as cobblestones, climbing steps and hill inclines is required.

There are numerous long touring days, with 8 hours of touring, excluding included dinners.

This tour features hotels that may not have air conditioning and may feature high sided bathtubs.

Not all hotels in Britain and Ireland have air conditioning.

Triple rooms and adjoining rooms are not common in this part of Europe and may not be available.

This tour includes a high-speed train from York to London. On this day, you will take your hand luggage with you on the train and your main luggage will be sent to the hotel. Your Tour Manager will travel with you. Please be advised this is a large and busy train station.
