Project On-Track Program Updates

- In November, 6000 books were distributed to approximately 2000 Project On-Track literacy students. Each student received three books to take home. The selected books included family reading activities. Literacy students will receive another three books in April.
- In January 2023, Project On-Track staff members delivered 730 family math kits to students at their respective schools. The kits included math manipulatives and a parent guide containing directions and math problems students and family members can solve together. Math students will receive a different family math kit in April.
- Project On-Track literacy and math specialists have trained 10 new tutors in January.
- All Project On-Track tutors are, currently, completing a course regarding trauma-informed care and appropriate practices. Trauma-informed specialist, Miranda Russell, is facilitating several sessions in January and February. Tutors may choose from a menu of training dates that fit their schedule.
- Project On-Track families received a newsletter and survey to complete at the end of January through the text messaging platform, Signal Vine. The newsletter included Project On-Track updates and parent tips. Families were asked to complete the short survey to provide feedback regarding Project On-Track.
