

AP Access for ALL Program Updates

- School Partnerships:
 - 121 School Systems 95% of all public, K-12 systems.
 - 31 systems are in At-Risk or Distressed Counties (representing 86% of all AR/Dis Counties)
 - o 48 systems are rural, representing 91% of all rural areas
 - o Enrollment for Fall 2023 will open in March
- Quick Stats
 - Spring course enrollment stands at 812
 - Year-long student enrollment stands at 2,102
 - 49 new AP teachers have been hired to serve these new spring students. There is a total of 133 AP Teachers this school year.
 - Awarded 86 APAA mini-grants for a total of \$36,000 at least one grant to each region – The App will stay open until the end of March. A direct link to the App can be found here.
 - AP Summer Institute applications continue to come in.
 Currently, 289 teachers have applied representing schools from all regions of the state.
- A Vanderbilt Implementation Study is supporting this work. Year 1 Data include the following:
 - 80% of schools that enrolled in Year 1 were grades 9-12
 - 7% were full virtual schools
 - 2% were charter schools
 - o 176 schools enrolled students
 - $\circ~192~AP$ liaisons 92% of them enrolled at least one student with us.
