State Route 330 Pavement Rehab in San Bernardino Mountains July 29 – August 2, 2024

SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) alerts the public that Construction Crews and Dry Creek maintenance crews will continue with the asphalt surfacing project on State Route 330 (SR-330) from Highland to Running Springs. *Weather permitting.*

Work will occur on Monday, July 29th to Thursday, August 1st from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and on Friday, August 2nd, work will occur from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Crews will be installing rumble strips along the centerline throughout the state route as part of the pavement rehab project.

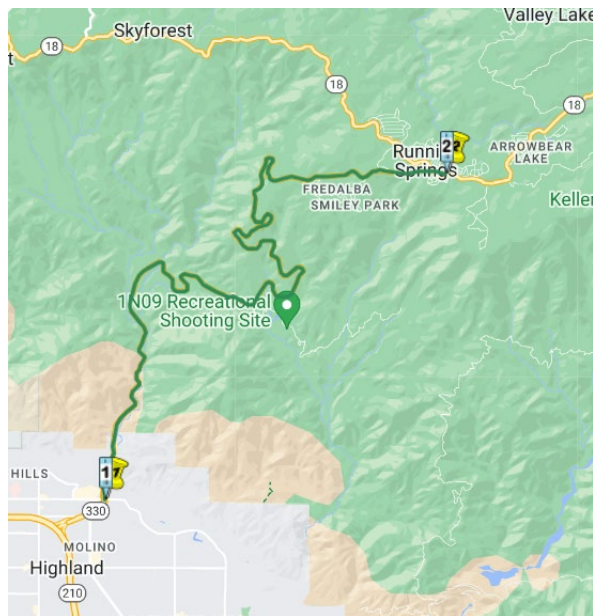
State Route 330 will remain open during construction. Flagging operations will be placed in sections throughout the State Route. Expect Delays up to 15 minutes. There will be intermittent, short-term closures for equipment relocation and construction staging purposes.

To avoid delays while traveling, utilize State Route 38 from Mentone or State Route 18 from San Bernardino.
