## State Route 138 & 189 Slurry Seal and Traffic Strips Various Locations

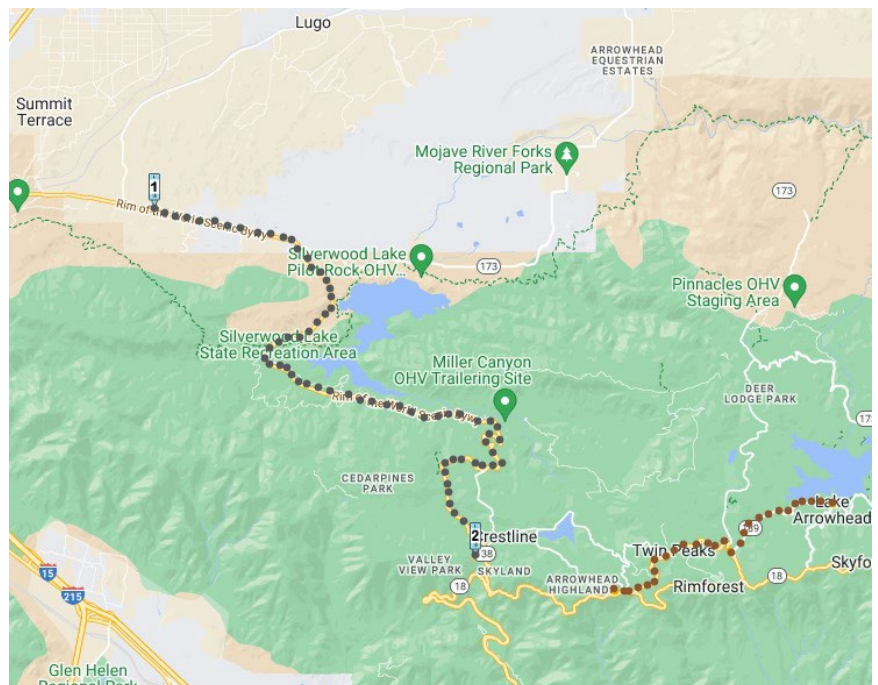
**SAN BERNARDINO, CA** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is announcing a \$4.4 million slurry seal and traffic strips maintenance project on State Route 138 (SR-138) and State Route 189 (SR-189) in San Bernardino County. The project will start at Bolingbroke Road and end at Rim of the World on Highway 18 (Hwy 18). The second portion of the project will start at Lake Gregory Dr. and end at Village Road.

**Work is anticipated to start on July 30, 2024, with operating hours from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday to Friday. Weather permitting.**

One-way traffic control with flagging will be in effect. While work may require temporary lane closures, expect traffic delays in the work area and be mindful of any signage indicating work area speed limits. The project is anticipated to be completed by late Fall 2024. *All work is dependent on the contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. It can be changed or canceled at any time.*
