Hwy 18 Bridge Maintenance July 2024 to August 2024

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting the public that construction contractors will begin daytime work on Highway State Route 18 (SR-18) in San Bernardino County. The purpose of the project is to perform preventive maintenance, including applying a polyester concrete overlay, upgrading signs, and repairing and enhancing the longevity of the bridge.


Daytime work will occur from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. This week, work will start on July 18th and 19th. Next week, work will resume Monday to Saturday, July 22nd to 27th. Daytime lane closures may occur if necessary. Drivers should take precautions and look for signs indicating detour routes and lane reductions.

During this time, **commuter access remains** as construction crews will be working on the bridge locations listed below. *Please note that all work is dependent on contractor receiving proper materials for each job function. It can be changed or canceled at any time.*

The following are planned bridge work locations:

- In San Bernardino on route 18/210 (BR #54 0770)
- In Running Springs on route 18/330 (BR #54 0031)
