Frequently Asked Questions

What? 4 to 6 in-person visits at Samuel Merritt University in Oakland (number of visits based on condition)

With whom? 2 to 3 physical therapy students and one licensed physical therapist faculty member

How long? Each visit will last for about 45 minutes

Requirements? Participants must be fully vaccinated and **commit to attend all treatment sessions.**
