- Memorize addition and subtraction facts from 1-18
- Memorize multiplication and division facts from 1-12
- Be able to recognize the different symbols for multiplication and division
- Be able to complete worksheets with mixed facts (some addition, some subtraction, some multiplication and some division)
- Know the difference between numerator and denominator
- Be able to identify and draw halves, thirds, and fourths in fractions
- Be able to order $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, and $\frac{1}{5}$ on a number line
