**WANT SOME IDEAS FOR THINGS TO WORK ON?  
BY THE END OF KINDERGARTEN, YOUR CHILD WILL BE EXPECTED TO:**

- Identify and write numbers to 20 (if mastered, continue to 100).
- Count orally up to 100, by both 1's and 10's.
- Count with 1:1 correspondence (i.e. pointing and counting each object one at a time).
- Know the names of flat shapes (circle, hexagon, rectangle, triangle, square)
- Know the names of 3D shapes (sphere, cylinder, cube, cone).
