1st Grade Summer Math Program at Bassett Elementary

Welcome to the First Grade 2018 Summer Math Program at Bassett! As you complete the Summer Reading Program, you can also complete our Summer Math Program by exploring eight animals that can be found living in the rainforest. To complete the math program, you need to do 10 minutes of math 3 times a week for 8 weeks of the summer. As you complete each 10 minutes of math, make a check mark in the table below. At the end of the week, color in the rainforest animal for that week. When you have colored in all eight animals, you have completed the program.

Keep this sheet in a safe place throughout the summer and bring it to Bassett when school starts in August. Students who complete the Summer Math Program will be recognized at an awards ceremony and will receive a small prize.

In kindergarten your child learned addition and subtraction facts from 0-5. Please reinforce those facts! Already comfortable with those facts? Move on to some of the goals students will work on in first grade.

BY THE END OF FIRST GRADE, YOUR STUDENT SHOULD BE ABLE TO:

- Identify and write numbers up to 120 correctly.
- Know addition and subtraction facts from 1-10. Practice, practice, practice!! During first grade, your child will take timed tests with 20 addition or subtraction problems that the children will need to complete in 1 minute! Already know them? Work on addition and subtraction facts from 1-18.
- Understand fact families (i.e. $2+8=10$, $8+2=10$, $10-2=8$, and $10-8=2$).
- Add 3 numbers to get to 10 ($2+3+5=10$, $1+6+3=10$, etc.).
