By “conflicts” we mean any day/time that your child will be unavailable for rehearsal. This includes weekdays and weekends, also it includes one time events and recurring events (practice/games/etc.) Availability will be taken into consideration as the casting decisions are made.

There will be show performances **March 3rd – 7th, 2021**.

**\*\*If your child is cast, there is a mandatory parent meeting the week after Thanksgiving. Location and time TBA.**

**WHO:** Auditions are open to 1st through 8th grade students only who attend FES, DES and HMS.

**WHERE:** Auditions will be held at Grace Evangelical Church (9750 Wolf River Blvd.) on November 17th and 19th from 4 - 7pm.

Drop off and pick up for auditions will take place from the church parking lot. Please wait in your car and text upon arrival. We will let you know when we are ready for your child to enter the building. Parents please wait in the car.

**WHAT TO BRING:** A completed Audition Form with conflicts listed and a current picture from the shoulders up (Headshot, recent school picture, any picture with shoulders up). This picture will not be returned.

Masks are required for auditions. Falcon Footlights will be complying with all GMSD Covid-19 regulations.

**AUDITION FORMAT:** Students will need to be prepared to perform the following during individual audition:

- Audition Song (from provided tracks - without guide vocals)
- Audition Monologue (from provided monologue - does NOT need to be memorized. Only if auditioning for host or emcee)
- Audition Dance - (provided video on website)

If you own ballet or jazz shoes, please bring them (but do not go purchase any). Wear comfortable clothes and shoes for movement; No flip flops, boots or sandals, please.

Students should be prepared for "on-the-spot" characterization of any role.

A cast of about 50-60 will be chosen for the Musical Revue. We will be holding Crew interviews in January if your child is interested, please check back to our Falcon Footlights Booster Club website for updates.

#### TIME AND FINANCIAL COMMITMENT:

It is important that each parent and student understand the time commitment before auditioning. If you have seen one of the Falcon Footlights shows before, you understand that it is not your typical school play. Being in this show does not mean that you can't participate in other activities, BUT individual conflicts will be a determining factor to cast the show. Typical rehearsals run 2 to 4 times a week from 4-5:30 and some Saturdays.

*\*\*DES, FHES, and HMS students should make arrangements to get to FES before practice begins at 4pm.\*\**

It is extremely important that your student's conflicts are listed on the audition form. There will be mandatory rehearsals as the show approaches.

Participation fees for the cast are \$150 and are paid by using your My School Bucks account.

**VOLUNTEER HOURS:** There will be 12 mandatory volunteer hours per family over the course of the show.

Opportunities for these volunteer hours will range from November - March and days/hours will vary. We need everyone's support to make this year's production a success.

There will be an option to pay \$150 in exchange for your hours, but what we really want and need is you! You are the ones who can help us best and we will work to find you a spot to volunteer that you can enjoy. Parents, Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles, friends and possibly older siblings can help you meet your volunteer requirement. We will explain more about this at the parent meeting.
