Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your student has expressed interest in participating in the Yearbook Executive Board. I would like to share with you some brief information regarding club activities, expectations, meeting times, dates, and locations.

Activities: Students will take part in creating the yearbook by taking photographs, interviewing students and teachers for stories, quotes and polls, and assisting in planning the overall design of the yearbook. This experience will allow for opportunities of leadership, teamwork, and creativity. Your child does not need a camera to participate. Children from grades 4 and 5 will be able to participate in Yearbook Club Executive Board.

Expectations: Most work will be conducted during our weekly board meetings. Rarely, a yearbook assignment/task will require work during the school day. In this case, I will coordinate these assignments with your child's teacher, which means board members will have to maintain the work and behavior standards set forth by their classroom teacher.

Meetings: Yearbook Board meetings will consist of lessons in leadership, group work, photography, marketing, design, event planning, editing, special guest speakers from the community, and possibly field trip to HMS and/or HHS to observe their yearbook staff in action. They will begin with the first meeting on September 5th and will continue weekly throughout the entire year. Meetings will be in Mrs. Mink's room from 7:45 – 8:30am. Club members must arrive on time as there will be much work (and fun) to do! Please notify the Yearbook Advisers, Mrs. Mink or Ms. Sweda, of any scheduled absences as soon as possible. Parents will be notified if a club meeting needs to be rescheduled. There may be times throughout the year in which only certain club members are asked to attend the meetings. This information will be communicated through Bloomz.

If your student would like to be considered to serve on the Yearbook Executive Board for the 2019-2020 school year, please be sure to review and sign the **Parent Approval Form** in this packet. All forms must be returned on or before the due date to be considered. Space is limited to 15 students.
