- 6. Recognition of 5 year, 10 year, 15 year, and 20 year members
- 7. Treasurer's Report Jan Albrecht
 - Presented OLLI's Financial principles:
 - Adopt a balanced budget every year
 Maintain a cash balance of 35% of annual expenses or a plan to restore if a capital project is underway (Presently the cash balance is 32% and should be restored to 35% by 2020-21)
 - 10 year forecast model is used to ensure long-term viability
 - When needed, raise member fees to keep up with rising costs, balance the budget, and/or to restore cash balance to target.

- Budget is balanced for 2018-19 with NO fee increase
- 2017-18 income was \$384,000 (from member fees, Osher endowment, fundraising, and sponsors/interest). Operating expenses were \$369,000 (for office staff/IT students, facilities/rent/parking, SOU business services, office operations, and member activities)
- Room A Renovation: \$15,000 was paid through income, \$42,700 was paid from our cash balance for a total cost of \$57,700.

8. President's Report – Allan Anderson

OLLI at SOU offers over 100 courses per term. Over the last year, we had 337 total courses with 249 unique titles. There were 213 instructors, 54 of them new. OLLI at SOU is one (if not THE) cheapest OLLI in the nation. Our Community Lecture series enrich and entertain, with presenters from OLLI, SOU, and the community.

9. Annual Member Survey – Barbara Klein

- Over 700 write-in comments (all comments are read by Council)
- Overall satisfaction = 4.3 stars, unchanged from last year
- Top two for "more courses wanted": history and arts courses
- Top scores: Office Support, New Room A, # of courses, Fees
- Most complaints: Campbell Center facilities

10. Campbell Center Renovation – Lorraine Vail

There is a model of the proposed renovation available for review. Rooms A, B and C have been renovated using existing funds; there are still a couple of items that need work. The south building renovation will be much more extensive; if all goes according to plan, that work will commence in summer 2019. Fundraising for the Capital Campaign has reached 50% of the goal.
