About NAWS Humane Society of Illinois



Founded in 2007 in Mokena, Illinois, NAWS is a 501c3 non-profit organization dedicated to ending euthanasia and suffering of companion animals through targeted low cost spay/neuter and wellness programs.

NAWS operates a 16,000 sq. foot “Campus” that houses our medical services, pet boarding, doggy day camp, a resale area and many of our adoptable dogs and cats. Our pet rescue focuses on pulling pets from high kill animal shelters in rural areas with medical conditions that we have the resources to treat, but which would most likely result in euthanasia in a rural shelter. We also accept pets from owners who can no longer care for their animals, offer discounted spay/neuter and wellness services to rescues and individuals in need, and work to rehome over 700 animals each year.
