Students are competing for paid summer internships with a participating union. Those unions are the Electricians, Pipefitters, Carpenters, Boilermakers, and Operators. The next step for these students is for them to attend an OSHA 10 Safety Certification Course, CPR Certification, Red Cross Certification, and an awards banquet in late April.

To participate in the schools' STA program, students must be a senior, enrolled in a Career and Technical Course, have excellent grades and attendance, and be highly recommended by their teacher as a diligent student learner.
