

Traditional Worship Organist

Salary: \$7,500

The Traditional Worship Organist is responsible for the 8:45 am Traditional Worship Service.

As Traditional Worship Organist they will be required to do the following:

- Provide musical leadership for the 8:45 am Traditional Worship service; including preludes, offertories, liturgies, and hymns.
- Be flexible to play organ, piano, and keyboard, as the worship service or song choice dictates.
- As scheduled provide musical leadership for midweek services, as well as others special services through the year.
- Be available to be scheduled on midweek holidays, such as midweek during Lent, Thanksgiving Eve, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day.
- Participate in selecting hymnody for Traditional Worship services in conversations with the Coordinator of Traditional Worship, the Pastors, and the Worship and Music Committee.
- Attend quarterly staff meetings.
- Work to ensure hymnody is based upon the lectionary/sermon series, church season, or themes selected for worship and is from primarily, but not limited to, our Lutheran hymnbooks (Evangelical Lutheran Worship- ELW and With One Voice- WOV).
- Provide musical leadership for funerals or weddings as need and as able.
- Work with the Coordinator of Traditional Worship to provide leadership in the absence of other Traditional Worship musicians
- Fill in for the Sanctuary Choir Accompanist in the their absence.
- Other duties as assigned by Pastors and Church Council
