



WHAT IS IT?

WorkSource Georgia Mountains (WSGM) administers the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Program and is funded by the federal government. Participants must be enrolled in training in a Growth and Demand Occupation through a local area approved school. (See Approved Program & Provider)

This is a federal grant program and **NOT A LOAN**. It can assist with costs related to **training expenses** (books, tuition, tools, uniforms and shoes, certification, licensing, testing fees, etc.). It may also be able to help with **transportation and childcare fees**.

How do I apply for WIOA funding?

Step 1: Attend a REQUIRED program overview session.
