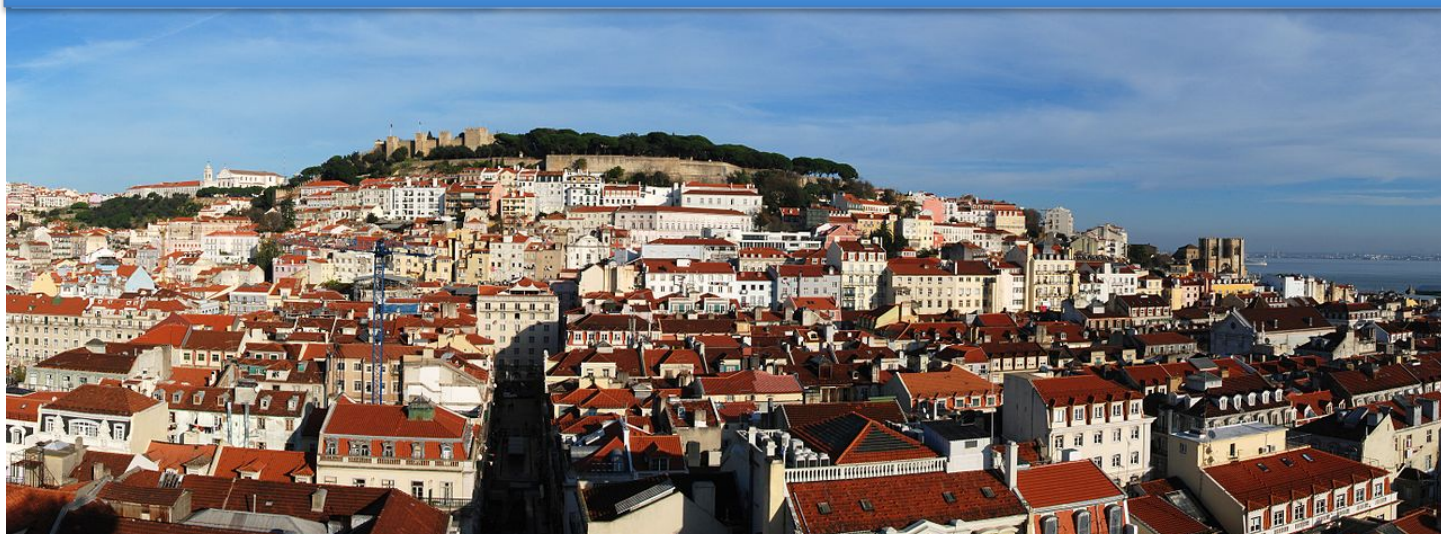

Portugal's incorporation into the European Union in 1986, has meant astounding prosperity for this fascinating Iberian nation. Portugal offers outstanding landscape diversity, due to its North-South disposition along the western shore of the Iberian peninsula. You can travel in a single day from green mountains in the North, covered with vines and all varieties of trees to rocky mountains, with spectacular slopes and falls, to a near-desert landscape in the Alentejo region and finally to the glamorous beach holidays destination Algarve. If you hunger to experience the splendor of European landscapes, culture and way of life, Portugal will satisfy your desires.

## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Oct 20, 2019 - Departure from the USA** on your overnight flight to Portugal

**Day 2: Oct 21, 2019 - Welcome to Lisbon!** Upon arrival, proceed through customs and collect your luggage. A Jet Vacations professional guide will personally greet you. Departure for a Panoramic tour of Lisbon by deluxe coach before drop off at the hotel. Check in and optional orientation tour around the hotel with our guide followed by some free time for lunch while the rooms are getting ready. Rest of the day at leisure. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner with the other group members. Overnight in Lisbon. (Dinner)

**Day 3: Oct 22, 2019 - Full Day tour of Lisbon.** After breakfast, meet your guide at the hotel and set off for your guided tour of Portugal's hilly capital. Board an air-conditioned minivan and head to Lisbon's riverside district of Belém and see two UNESCO World Heritage-listed monuments. First, visit the 16th-century Jeronimos Monastery and listen as your guide explains how the ornate arches and abundance of pinnacles is a prime example of Portuguese Manueline-style architecture. Nearby, see the Belém Tower, where soldiers once gazed over the Tagus River searching for incoming invaders. Continue to the Monument to the Discoveries which honors Portugal's Age of Discoveries and its navigators who left to explore trade opportunities with India and the Orient. Free time for lunch in Lisbon. Afterward, continue to Mãe d'Água (Mother of Water), a massive reservoir built between the 18th and 19th century that stored water from the Águas Livres aqueduct. Inside, see a small museum dedicated to the history of water supply in the city. Access the terrace for an impressive view over Lisbon. Next, stretch your legs with a walking tour through Lisbon's historic center. See some of the traditional neighborhoods like Castelo, Mouraria, and Alfama, the city's oldest district. Learn about the influence of the Moors in this 8th-century neighborhood and then meander around narrow streets up to Graça viewpoint, where you can take in one of the best bird's eye views of Lisbon. Your tour will conclude with drop-off at the hotel. This evening enjoy a dinner and Fado show (typically Portuguese) Overnight in Lisbon. (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 4: Oct 23, 2019 - Sintra and Cascais Coast.** Breakfast at the hotel. Today, depart on a full day trip and feast your senses on the splendid scenery of Sintra, a UNESCO listed village. Alongside your guide, you'll witness the fairy-tale beauty of the Pena Palace. Considered the greatest example of 19th-century Romanticism in the world, the palace sprawls on a hilltop high above Sintra, and can often be seen from Lisbon, 17 miles away. Continue to the National Palace of Sintra, a palace shrouded in a thousand years' worth of history. There will be some free time in Sintra before Lunch at a local Portuguese culinary restaurant. In the afternoon, follow your guide on a tour of the coastal village of Colares. Then return to your coach and admire views of the Portuguese countryside as you travel to Cabo da Roca: Europe's westernmost point. Gaze at the crashing waves of the Atlantic Ocean before returning to your coach and travelling to Hell's Mouth cliff (Boca do Inferno) a dramatic collection of caves carved by the vigorous waves of the Atlantic. Resume the drive along the picturesque Estoril Coast and enjoy panoramic views of the Casino Estoril, one of Europe's biggest casinos, believed to be where Ian Fleming (the author of the James Bond series) developed the idea for Casino Royale. Quick stop in Cascais Bay time permitting. After your tour, admire the beautiful green colors of the Portuguese countryside on your way back to your hotel in Lisbon. Evening on your own. Overnight in Lisbon. (Breakfast and Lunch)

**Day 5: Oct 24, 2019 - Optional Day Trip to Evora with Lunch from Lisbon.** After breakfast, enjoy the day at leisure to discover the beautiful city of Lisbon on your own or join an optional tour to Evora, the famous UNESCO town. During the scenic journey through the Alentejo region, your guide provides a historical overview of Evora's prosperous past. Your first stop is Giraldo Square, an architectural amalgamation of Moorish arches, Renaissance fountains and a Gothic church. After capturing photographs, head to one of Portugal's most famous landmarks: Templo de Diana (Temple of Diana). Marvel at 14 original Corinthian columns, impeccably preserved and shrouded in history, before arriving at your third stop. The Capela dos Ossos (Chapel of Bones) is a nightmarish church constructed entirely from the skulls and skeletons of 5,000 monks, and is also home to two intact corpses. Satisfy your appetite in an Évora restaurant favored by locals and then ascend Evora Cathedral's tower to enjoy panoramic city vistas. Enjoy some free time before returning to Lisbon. Overnight in Lisbon. (Breakfast)

**Day 6: Oct 25, 2019 - Nazaré and Porto.** Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, transfer to Porto and stop en-route in Nazaré, a fishing village that resonates with natural beauty. Famed for its seafood, you'll enjoy lunch in a traditional seafood tavern. In the afternoon, continue to Porto and check into your hotel. Overnight in Porto. (Breakfast, Lunch)

**Day 7: Oct 26, 2019 - Porto walking tour.** Breakfast at the hotel Meet your guide in the lobby and departure to the Praça Gomes Teixeira, also known as the Lions Square, for a walk through the historic city center. Get to know the city's history and how it developed with the arrival of the Romans, know about the Moorish and Castilian invasions and more recently in the nineteenth century by Napoleon's troops. See Livraria Lello & Irmão, the Clerics church and the beautiful São Bento Train Station, built on the site of a former Benedictine convent already inside the walled city. This is also one of the landmarks of the city and one of the most known stations in the world. Back on the street, go up to the Cathedral and the convent of Santa Clara. Return to the hotel and rest of the day at leisure to explore Porto on your own. Overnight in Porto. (Breakfast)

**Day 8: Oct 27, 2019 - Douro Valley Day trip from Porto with 1h cruise and wine tasting.** Breakfast at the hotel. Today enjoy a visit to the most emblematic places of the Douro Valley, such as, Peso da Regua, Pinhão, traditional villages, and more. Your guide will take you to different monuments and landscapes in the region, getting a sense of the history and culture that still thrives. During the tour, you'll also enjoy a beautiful farewell lunch at a local restaurant in Pinhão, getting a taste of the regional cuisine. In the afternoon, see the sights from the river in Pinão on a 1-hour cruise. Continue to visit a winery of a worldwide known wine producers to learn about the production of local wines followed by a wine tasting. Return to the hotel in Porto and rest of evening is at leisure as we prepare to depart the next day. Overnight in Porto. (Breakfast, lunch)

**Day 9: Oct 28, 2019 - Departure day.** Breakfast at the hotel and coach departure to the airport from the hotel with assistant. End of our services.

### Day 1: Oct 17, 2019 - Departure from the USA to Spain

### Day 2: Oct 18, 2019 - Welcome to Barcelona!

Upon arrival, proceed through customs and collect your luggage. A Jet Vacations professional guide will personally greet you. Departure for a orientation tour of Barcelona by deluxe coach before drop off at the hotel. Check in and optional orientation tour around the hotel with our guide followed by some free time for lunch while the rooms are getting ready. Rest of the day at leisure. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner. Overnight in Barcelona. (B, D)

### Day 3: Oct 19, 2019 – Barcelona with Gaudi

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your morning tour with a ride to the top of the famous Montjuic mountain, where you will receive a great overview of this amazing city. Drive by the Olympic Stadium where the Olympic Games were celebrated in 1992, as well the National Art Museum. Head down to the elegant Passeo de Gracia with its exclusive shops and Antonio Gaudi's two most iconic houses, Casa Batlló and La Pedrera. Learn about the Gothic Quarter, the center of the old city. Gaze at the remains of the squared Roman Wall, Las Ramblas and Barcelona's most famous markets, the Boqueria market, first mentioned in 1217. In the afternoon we discover **Gaudi** featuring La Familia Segrada. Begin your tour at La Sagrada Familia, a pioneering example of modernist architecture. Gaudi's unfinished masterpiece is unanimously hailed as Barcelona's city symbol. Once inside, gaze upwards at a dynamic tableau of light and color: columns shoot upwards to the seemingly interminable ceiling and sunlight floods through prismatic stained-glass windows in a dramatic spectrum of color. Dinner at leisure and overnight in Barcelona. (B, L)

### Day 4: Oct 20, 2019 – Barcelona at leisure – Optional Dali's Figueres & Girona tour

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a free day in Barcelona or optional full day tour to Figueres & Girona. Start your private guided tour and enjoy a scenic 2-hour drive to Figueres, home of the Dalí Theatre-Museum. Dive into the work of one of the greatest surrealist artists in history inside a museum space designed by Dalí himself. Arrive in the city of Girona at around 1:30 p.m. Enjoy a light lunch before beginning your 2-hour walking tour of the old city. Visit the Call (Jewish quarter), Church of Sant Feliu, the Cul de la Lleona, Church of Sant Lluc, the Arab baths, and the Girona Cathedral (entrance fees included). Climb up the old walls for a stellar view over the city, then descend toward La Rambla to see the bridges over the Onyar River, as well as the characteristic colorful houses that line its banks. Return to your hotel in Barcelona at around 6 p.m. Overnight in Barcelona. (B)

### Day 5: Oct 21, 2019

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the airport for the flight to Lisbon.

## POST-TOUR TO NORTHERN SPAIN & BASQUE COUNTRYSIDE

### Day 9: Oct 28, 2019 - Departure Porto and drive to Leon

After breakfast at the hotel, depart to Leon. Capital of a former Kingdom with a sense of strength and greatness, Leon faces the future with fresh, open-minded and proud of his legacy. Know the city of lights and colors and important stage for legendary travelers, through their places, traditions and customs. In this tour we visit the main sightseeing places in the city, including: The Cathedral of the Blessed Mother, Sierra Pambe Museum, Gastronomic quarter, Old abattoir house, the Jewish quarter, Old town hall, Gaudi house, to name a few. Lunch will be on your own. Check into your hotel. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Leon. (B, D)

### Day 10: Oct 29, 2019 - Bilbao!

Breakfast at your hotel and transfer to Bilbao and stop on the way in Santander. Lying in the heart of northern Spain's Cantabria region, the old port city of Santander has long been a favorite vacation spot for Madrileños who head there to escape the central Spanish summer heat, lounge on the beaches and admire the sights! This 12th century gothic-style architecture is one of the city's most impressive. Admire panoramic views of more wonderful Santander attractions, such as Gran Casino near El Sardinero beach and Magdalena Palace, the summer home of King Alfonso XIII. Enjoy lunch on your own in Santander. Arrive in Bilbao – Evening at leisure and overnight at your hotel in Bilbao. (B)

### Day 11: Oct 30, 2019 – Bilbao

After breakfast at the hotel, explore Bilbao's atmospheric Old Town and Ensanche neighborhood, browse the stalls at the La Ribera market, and marvel at architectural wonders such as the San Mames Stadium, and Bilbao Cathedral. At the end of the walking tour, stop for a tasting of two pintxos and two drinks. After your light lunch, meet up with your guide for a guided visit to the famous Guggenheim Museum, one of the city's most recognizable architectural landmarks. Explore the enthralling exhibitions of the museum in order to discover contemporary and modern art masterpieces; see timeless masterworks like Joseph Beuy's 'Lightning with Stag in its Glare' and gaze at Jeff Koons' colossal sculpture 'Puppy'. Gain fascinating insight into different art movements and hear tales of the intriguing lives of some of the artists during this culturally enriching exploration. Evening at leisure and overnight at your hotel in Bilbao. (B, L)

### Day 12: Oct 31, 2019 – Optional: Free day or San Sebastian

Free day or optional tour to San Sebastian. Depart the hotel to San Sebastian. Upon arrival, we will walk along the La Concha beach on the way to the old part of the city. Your private tour guide will point out historical points of interest including the Catedral de Buen Pastor, the Basilica de Santa Maria and the plaza constitución in the center of the old quarter of the city. The tour also includes a visit to the picturesque outlook of Mt. Igeldo overlooking the entire city of San Sebastian. A stop in the fishing port of Getaria. Getaria has some of the best restaurants in the Basque Country along with San Sebastian. A short drive to the unique coastal village of Zumaia is the next stop, with its famous rock formations containing fossils that date back some 100 million years. Here you will find some of the most breathtaking vistas in the entire Basque Country. Throughout this tour of San Sebastian and the Basque coast we will stop for a delicious pintxos light lunch, some visually stunning photo opportunities and easy treks. Final dinner in typical restaurant. Overnight at your hotel in Bilbao. (B)

### Day 13: Nov 01, 2019

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight back to the USA.

**Air arrangements:** Fares and schedules are based on regular scheduled carrier service. All applicable airline rules apply and schedules are subject to change. Basic airfares include fuel surcharges, airport departure taxes, passenger facility charges (PFCs), customs or immigration fees, but do not include excess baggage charges and any other airline imposed charges. For mileage accrual information, please contact the carrier directly for details. Air inclusive group packages are non-changeable and non-refundable once deposit has been paid. Rules and fees for canceling and revising airfares vary depending upon the type of airfare purchased. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

**Seat assignments:** We block group seats with many major carriers, as well as chartered air carriers. We have absolutely no control over seat assignment. Specific seat requests are subject to availability at airport check-in only or passengers may contact the airlines for individual specific seating once tickets have been issued. Passenger "Record locators" are assigned by the airlines once the airlines have ticketed each passenger from the group block. This usually occurs between 60 to 30 days prior the departure date. After the airlines have assigned each traveler a "record locator", travelers may contact the airlines directly to discuss his or her seat preference. Airlines may impose additional fees for specific seats.

**Cancellation Policies:** No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 120 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients may be non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or may be subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

**Full cancellation:** Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:  
 Initial deposit\*\*: non-refundable.

From 180 to 91 days prior departure: 35% penalty of the total cost per person.  
 From 90 to 61 days prior departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.  
 From 60 to 31 days prior departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.  
 From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.

Situations may arise, voluntarily or involuntarily, that require changes or exceptions in the airport of departure, the itinerary, land arrangements, hotels, trains or ports of call. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

**Minimum participants to Operate:** Group needs a minimum of 20 participants to operate. Optional tours need a minimum of 15 participants to operate.

**Tour Cancellation:** We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited to and liquidated by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.
