Subject: Notice of Public Hearing Regarding Superintendent Employment Contract

Dear Franklin Lakes Residents,

In compliance with New Jersey law (N.J.S.A. 18A:11-11), the Franklin Lakes Board of Education hereby provides notice of a public hearing to be held on **April 14, 2026 at 7:30PM**, to discuss the proposed employment contract for the Superintendent of Schools, Gregorio Maceri.

The proposed agreement covers a four-year term effective **July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2030**.

Public Comment Period & Meeting Details State law requires a 30-day notice period to allow for public transparency and community input before a Board of Education can take final action on a superintendent's contract.

- **Public Hearing Date:** April 14, 2026
- **Purpose:** To allow the public to provide testimony and comments regarding the terms and conditions of the proposed contract.
- **Board Action:** Following the public hearing, the Board intends to vote on the final approval of the contract during the same meeting.

Legal Compliance The Board has followed all statutory requirements leading up to this hearing:

- **Executive Review:** The contract will be submitted to the **Executive County Superintendent** for review and approval to ensure it meets all state standards for compensation and benefits under N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-3.1.
- **Transparency:** This 30-day notice ensures the community is fully informed and has the opportunity to participate in the governance of our district schools.

We invite all interested members of the community to attend the hearing during our regular business meeting on April 14th.
