

OLLI at UMass Boston – Getting Here Campus Shuttle Information

The free campus shuttle services the **JFK/UMass Boston T Station**, Bayside Parking Lot, residence halls, JFK Library/Mass Archives, the **Campus Center**, and the **Integrated Science Complex/West Garage**. It basically makes a big loop around the campus (going clockwise).

On the campus map, shuttle stops are indicated by pink dots enclosed in yellow circles.

The shuttle stops are:

- JFK/UMass Station
- Bayside Inbound (by St. Christopher's Catholic Church) – Pick-up for Bayside Parking lot
- Mt Vernon @ University Drive Inbound (by the Residence Halls)
- JFK Library/Commonwealth Museum Inbound
- Campus Center (best option for access to McCormack Hall & Wheatley Hall)
- University Drive West Outbound – Across from the West Garage (best option for access to Integrated Sciences Center)
- Mt Vernon @ University Drive Outbound – Drop-off for Bayside Parking Lot
- Bayside Outbound
- JFK/UMass Station



At the JFK/UMass Boston T Stop, the boarding area for the UMass Boston campus shuttle is located by a black information booth (which is not in use) on the street level. After going through the fare gates for the Red Line, turn right and proceed down the stairs or ramp. You will see the black wooden booth alongside an enclosed bus shelter. For those using the commuter rail, once you leave the platform, you will head over to the bus area (look for the black information booth).



The shuttles are operated by Paul Revere and typically are either a white bus with "Paul Revere" on the side or it is a "wrapped/painted" bus with the UMass Boston colors and logo. Please note there is a shuttle for the Longwood Medical Area (LMA Shuttle) that takes employees to Longwood. It is also a blue bus, and you

will not want to get on that as it will not take you to campus. You can always ask the bus driver to make sure you are on the right shuttle for the UMass Boston campus.
