- View icons like Big Ben, the London Eye, Tower Bridge, and the Tower of London.
- Stop by Buckingham Palace, where you may catch the Changing of the Guard.

Day 4: Sightseeing tour of the Royal Opera House

This morning, journey to Covent Garden for a behind-the-scenes look through the Royal Opera House with an expert guide leading the way.

- Beginning in the cloakroom on the ground floor, set off with your guide to discover some of the secrets and spaces typically off limits to the public.
- Walk through rehearsal studios where the Royal Opera and Royal Ballet performers practice, as well as the costume and production workshops where seamstresses and craftsman create ornate and extravagant clothes and sets.
- Take a deep dive into the history of the theatre from 1731, through World War II, to present day.

Day 6: Theatre walking tour of London

Day 7: Sightseeing tour of the Globe Theatre

Spend the afternoon inside the world-renowned Globe Theatre, where many of Shakespeare's plays were performed. You'll join a local guide for a tour and interactive lecture of the theatre followed by free time to explore the theatre.

Day 8: Kew Gardens, the London Eye & farewell dinner

Visit Kew Gardens, London's largest UNESCO World Heritage site and home of the most diverse biological collections in the world.

- Explore the gardens with an award-winning guide, learning about the history and work that goes into caring for the plants.
- Visit the glasshouses to identify different species of exotic plants.
- Enjoy free time to explore on your own or enjoy refreshments in the cafe.

This evening, take in spectacular views of the city's skyline from the London Eye. Take a tour through the Covent Garden area of the West End before celebrating your trip with your group at a farewell dinner.

Day 9: Departure

Day 3: Windsor Castle

\$125 (5 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Led by a Blue Badge Guide, you'll travel to Windsor for a guided tour of the world's largest and longest-inhabited castle. Founded by William the Conqueror in 1070, Windsor has been the British Royal Family's preferred retreat for the past 900 years. Step inside the State Apartments and St. George's Chapel, where knighting ceremonies of the Most Noble Order of the Garter take place. View the exhibit of royal treasures within the castle. You'll then have time to stroll through the town of Windsor and have a look at Eton College, a prestigious prep school attended by Princes William and Harry. Please note: When the Windsor Castle excursion falls on a Wednesday, entrance will be replaced by an excursion to Hampton Court. For any departures where the Windsor Castle excursion falls on a Tuesday, the excursion will be moved to another day on tour or cancelled. Additionally, St. George's Chapel is closed to the public on Sundays. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Jewels as you go. Explore exhibitions about the Royal Mint and old armaments before watching a live historical reenactment and visiting the White Tower. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 5: Stonehenge & Salisbury

\$149 (7 hours, departs in the morning)

After a scenic drive through gently rolling countryside, arrive at Stonehenge, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of England's most recognizable icons. Get an informative overview of its history at the visitor's center before exploring the monument. Then, head to the nearby town of Salisbury to peruse its famed Charter Market and visit Salisbury Cathedral, home to one of the four surviving original copies of the Magna Carta. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 6: Westminster Abbey & Afternoon Tea

\$159 (5 hours, departs in the afternoon with tea and snacks)

Visit Westminster Abbey, the famous Gothic church near the Houses of Parliament. With a local guide leading the way, you'll discover Westminster's storied history. Learn about its service as a coronation church for the monarchy since 1066 and resting place of many important Britons, from Queen Elizabeth I to Isaac Newton and Charles Dickens. Then, sit down for afternoon tea where you will enjoy the classic English tradition accompanied by specialties like finger sandwiches, scones and clotted cream, and pastries. This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked at least 20 days prior to departure.

Day 7: Tower of London

\$109 (3 hours, departs in the morning)

Enter the Tower of London, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its dark history of treason, imprisonment, and beheadings. With a local Blue Badge Guide leading the way, you'll explore the nooks and crannies of this royal castle, seeing ancient coin collections, suits of armor, and the glittering Crown
