

OLLI at UMass Boston – Getting Here

Public Transportation and Off-Campus Parking

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

JFK/UMass T Station

- For folks taking the **Red Line** or Commuter Rail, you will want to get off at the JFK/UMass station. After going through the fare gates for the Red Line, turn right and proceed down the stairs or ramp. The boarding area for the UMass Boston campus shuttle is located by a black information booth (which is not in use).
- The free campus shuttles are operated by Paul Revere and typically are either a white bus with "Paul Revere" on the side or it is a "wrapped/ painted" bus with the UMass Boston colors and logo. *Please note there is a shuttle for the Longwood Medical Area (LMA Shuttle) that takes employees to Longwood. It is also a blue bus, and you will not want to get on that as it will not take you to campus.* You can always ask the bus driver to make sure you are on the right shuttle for the UMass Boston campus.
- **Commuter Rail.** Three commuter lines serving the South Shore ([Greenbush](#), [Kingston](#), and [Fall River/New Bedford](#)) have stops at the UMass Boston/JFK Station? **Check them out** to see if there is one that would allow you to get to UMass Boston's campus. From the UMass/JFK Station, you can take the free campus shuttle to the Campus Center. The boarding area for the campus shuttle is across from the commuter rail platform by a black information booth (which is not in use).

The #8 and #16 MBTA buses drop people off at the residence halls at the intersections of Mt. Vernon Street and University Drive West.

The Ride also serves the UMass Boston Campus and will pick-up/drop-off people at the Campus Center.

Uber/Lyft. If members are using a ride-share service such as Uber or Lyft, there is a drop-off/pick-up location at the Campus Center as well as the Integrated Science Complex (ISC). These two locations also serve a general pick-up/drop-off location if you are having a friend or family member drive you to campus.

OFF-CAMPUS PARKING

IMPORTANT: You must pay for parking on the mobile app before leaving your car.

The Bayside parking lot (200 Mt. Vernon Street) is the only off-campus parking option for students, employees, and guests. Parking at Bayside (**\$9.45**) **can only be paid for by a mobile phone app**. The Passport Parking app is available in the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. Bayside is identified as **Zone 21251** which you will need when paying by this app. You then take the free UMass Boston shuttle from Bayside to the campus. If you are familiar with paying parking costs by mobile apps, please consider this option.
