### ***About The Lacebark Elm***

This handsome, graceful tree has a rounded crown adorned with lustrous dark green leaves that change to yellow and reddish-purple in fall.

A landscape standout, the lacebark elm has distinctive bark, which is mottled and often creates colorful patterns in its trunk. Medium to fast-growing, this elm adapts to many soil conditions and is relatively free from the diseases ravaging other elm species, making it a tough and durable tree.
