Entry Level Driver Training (ELDT)

The Entry Level Driver Training requirements will take effect February 7, 2022. This session will provide an overview of the training requirements for future entry-level drivers. This seminar will also discuss the Training Provider Registry, which is now open.

After the effective date the ELDT requirements will apply to those:

Obtaining a Class A or Class B CDL for the first time;

Upgrading an existing Class B CDL to a Class A CDL; Obtaining a school bus (S), passenger (P), or hazardous materials (H) endorsement for the first time.

November 16, 2021 9:00am-10:00am

Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse (DACH)

This session will include a review of the drug and alcohol clearinghouse, the requirements for employers and drivers, how to register and conduct queries, along with the use of consent forms and more.

We will also discuss common violations that have occurred since January 2020 when the DACH was established. We will also review the resources available on the DACH website that can walk you through registration or queries.
