At this meeting, you, the owners, will be voting on four open Board positions to fill the vacancies of current members whose terms expire. The Association is currently accepting applications from individuals with an interest in serving on the Board of Directors. The Board is made up of seven Spectrum homeowners who meet monthly to make decisions on behalf of the community and assist in formulating community goals. The qualifications are:

- Must be an owner of property within the Spectrum Community Association and be in good standings.
- Must have an interest in serving and making a positive difference within the community where you live.
- A commitment to uphold the Spectrum Community Association Governing Documents.
- An ability to listen and make informed decisions in the best interest of the community.
- A time commitment to attend Board/Committee meetings, as well as additional time to communicate with other homeowners.
- Time commitment is estimated at 2-5 hours per month, additional time may be required for research on specific issues or attending community events.
- Serve a two year term.

Regular Board of Directors' meetings are currently held on the last Wednesday of each month at 6pm. Board responsibilities cover a broad spectrum of activities for the entire property and services. When elected, your satisfaction as a volunteer director will come from helping to make a great community even better.

To volunteer and run for the Board, simply complete the Application Form on the reverse side and return it to the community office by <u>5:00pm, Friday, March 13, 2020</u>. If you choose not to run for the Board of Directors, we hope that you will consider volunteering for one of the many committees working to support the Association. Community involvement at many levels is the key to the ongoing success of Spectrum. Become active in supporting your community, and let us hear from you!
