Place all acceptable bulk items in the street against the curb.

Place out no earlier than the Saturday prior to your collection week and no later than 5:00 AM on Monday of your collection week.



## WHAT IS BULK TRASH?

- Bulk trash pickup is a service for items that are too large to fit in your trash container.
- Household trash is not accepted for bulk pick up and should be bagged and placed in your trash container.
- Pick up may occur any day during your collection week.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Furniture that cannot be donated</li><li>• Mattresses</li><li>• Dishwashers</li><li>• Yard waste</li><li>◦ Trimmings less than 5 feet in length and 12 inches in diameter</li><li>◦ Grass, leaves, and weeds (bagged and tied)</li><li>◦ Cacti (boxed and contained)</li><li>• Glass (boxed, sealed, and labeled)</li><li>• Televisions (CRT, DLP, Rear Projection)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Daily household garbage</li><li>• Remodeling debris (drywall, roofing material, countertops, cabinets, carpet, glass doors, and mirror doors)</li><li>• Auto parts (engine block, tires, and rims)</li><li>• Hazardous waste (antifreeze, gasoline, oil, paint, and electronics)</li><li>◦ These items are accepted at our <a href="#">Household Hazardous Waste Facility</a> (480) 503-6400 2224 E Queen Creek Road Gilbert, AZ 85297</li><li>• Concrete, dirt, rock, and sod</li><li>• Major appliances (washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, and water heaters)</li><li>◦ These items are collected separately as part of <a href="#">our Appliance Recycling Program</a></li></ul>

### Special Pick Ups

Bulk trash piles that exceed 10' x 5' x 5' can be collected for a nominal fee. Special collections start at a minimum rate of \$33.00/15 minute increment. Tonnage fees may also apply. Call Customer Service at **(480) 503-6400** to arrange for a special pick up. Special pickups must be scheduled and confirmed BEFORE they are set out for service.

### Want to haul it yourself?

There are two designated transfer stations available for Gilbert residents to dispose of one load of waste once every 30 days at no cost.
