# 2023 MLK Day of Service

DAYS OF SERVICE MINI GRANT PROGRAM



The Virginia Service Foundation is now accepting applications for the 2023 MLK Day of Service mini grant program! These mini grants are available for public or private nonprofit organizations hosting service projects to engage communities in service. Observed each year on the third Monday in January, MLK Day is the only federal holiday designated as a National Day of Service to encourage all Americans to volunteer to improve their communities.

Mini grants are available to eligible organizations for up to \$250. **Applications must be submitted by November 7**<sup>th</sup> **at midnight.** Preferred submission is through the online form available <a href="here">here</a>, but PDF forms for manual entry are available upon request.

# **Eligibility**

Applicants must represent public or private nonprofit organizations that serve the Commonwealth of Virginia. This includes faith-based and other community organizations, public or private schools, institutions of higher education and government entities. The funding will be provided on a reimbursement basis to the applying organization after the reimbursement request is received by the Virginia Service Foundation.

#### **Timeline**

October 17, 2022 - Notice of Mini Grant Funding Opportunity
November 7, 2022 - Applications Deadline
By November 28, 2022 - Award Announcements
January 14-16, 2023 - Projects take place\*

\*While your project may occur on a date outside of this weekend, all projects must be completed in January 2023.

Note: ALL invoices must be submitted within 30 days of the completed project date.

### **Service Project Guidelines**

Making time to volunteer for MLK Day of Service is a great way to engage with your community while honoring the legacy of Dr. King. Whether you plan on cleaning up a public space, mentoring a young person, or assisting those who are food insecure, what you do makes a world of difference.

Service projects must engage volunteers but are not required to focus on a specific topic area or include a specific elements. Applicants are encouraged to consider the connection between their project and the legacy of Dr. King, however, there is no requirement for projects to add this if it is not already an element of the planned project.

Does your project have any planned connection to the legacy of Martin Luther King Jr., MLK Day of Service, or incorporate elements like civic reflection? If so, please describe.
