# STATE PLAN

A summary of what it is and how agencies can get involved.

## **PURPOSE**

- According to Section 676(b) of the CSBG Act, states must prepare and submit a State Plan for CSBG funding. OCS provides funds to CSBG grantees based on the determination that their State Plan, which also serves as an application, is complete and in accordance with all requirements of the CSBG Act.
- The CSBG State Plan is a critical document for both state and federal oversight of CSBG. The CSBG State Plan integrates and aligns requirements from the CSBG Act with elements of the overall CSBG Performance Management and Accountability framework.
