AFO's Senator Mark O. Hatfield Architectural Award was established in 1998 to annually recognize Oregon architecture students for their design promise and community service. Since 1998, AFO has awarded 27 scholarships to exceptional students, many of whom now practice in the Northwest and around the world.

The William Hart Scholarship was established in 2021 in partnership with Carleton Hart Architecture. Throughout his career, Hart has significantly contributed to community-oriented projects that are sensitive to historically under-represented stakeholders, including multiple affordable housing developments and community centers across the Portland-Metro Area and SW Washington. This scholarship aims to build on that work by awarding to eligible students of color.
