In 2016, this program provided 381 elementary, middle, and high school children in Summit, eligible for free or reduced lunch, with new backpacks and school supplies. Parents were able to take the financial resources that would have been used for school supplies to pay for basic necessities such as food and rent. Most importantly, these children went to school prepared and excited for the business of learning.
