We are collecting canned goods for The Lord's Pantry again this year. Students may turn in items to their class sponsor any day of the week or students may turn in money to purchase canned goods. This year, we will have 3 COUNTING days to earn Sherwood Cup points for each grade. The points will be given weekly based on the highest number of cans and/or money on each counting day.

Weekly winners:

1<sup>st</sup> place – 200 points    2<sup>nd</sup> place – 150 points    3<sup>rd</sup> place – 100 points    4<sup>th</sup> place 50 points

## Counting days:

**Week 1 on Friday, November 6**

**Week 2 on Friday, November 13**

**Week 3 on Wednesday, November 18**

**\$1.00 = 2 cans**

\*Each grade has a goal set for them containing the number of cans and/or money that they need to achieve. Every grade that meets the goal by the last counting day will get a dress down WEEK (jeans and SCA shirts) the week before Christmas break and 100 Sherwood cup points. The Goal is based on the number of students in each grade. (\$5 and 10 cans per student)

6<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$115 and 230 cans/23 students

7<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$160 and 320 cans/32 students

8<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$155 and 310 cans/31 students

9<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$115 and 23 cans/23 students

10<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$150 and 300 cans/30 students

11<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$160 and 320 cans/32 students

12<sup>th</sup> grade goal: \$140 and 280 cans/28 students

TEACHERS:

\*A tally form will need to be filled out daily for each grade by STUCO officers with sponsor approval.

\*Tally forms and canned goods will be collected daily by student council members.
